

## OSHC BOOKINGS, CANCELLATIONS, CHARGES & CHANGES

Cancellations or bookings must be made in writing at least 24 hours in advance for a normal rate of \$25 to apply and for cancellations not to be charged (Before 2:30pm for ASC and before 7am for BSC the day prior of booking or required booking). **Bookings made less than 24 hours in advance will be charged \$35 per child.**

*Vacation Care* enrolment forms received after the submission date will incur an additional cost of \$50 per child.

Vacation Care requires 2 days in advance written notification for cancellations.

The *Change of Bookings* Form can be obtained from the front office and from the OSHC building. All bookings and cancellations must be in writing and made through the front office. Email accepted, please email: [admin.holyspirit@nt.catholic.edu.au](mailto:admin.holyspirit@nt.catholic.edu.au)

A \$50 late fee (plus \$1 per minute) per child will apply if your child is collected after 5:30pm.

As per the Terms and Conditions on the OSHC enrolment form, public holidays will be charged if the front office has not received a cancellation of booking for that date.

Students who have not been collected by 2:45pm will be sent to OSHC to ensure supervision. Once a child is signed in at OSHC the casual rate will be charged.

Emergency contacts and people approved for collection of children must show identification when collecting students from OSHC and be of at least 18 years of age.

## OSHC—IMPORTANT NOTICE

It is a requirement that **All children** attending Holy Spirit Catholic Primary School complete a 2019 enrolment form for **Holy Spirit Out of School Hours Care** – regardless of whether they are a current user of this service or not.

A casual rate of \$35 per child will apply if your child/children attend Holy Spirit Out of School Hours Care without giving 24 hours' notice. This will include children that have not been collected from parent pick-up by 2:45pm and have been signed in by the teacher on duty or bookings made on the same day. A copy of the enrolment paperwork for Holy Spirit Out of School Hours Care will be sent out to families that have not completed a 2019 form. Completed forms must be returned to the **front office** no later than Friday the 8<sup>th</sup> of February, 2019. Families will be charged the normal rate of \$25 per child per day until the 8<sup>th</sup> of February, 2019 and the casual rate of \$35 thereafter if forms are not completed and returned to the front office. Children who return the form by the 8<sup>th</sup> of February will receive a ticket for a **free icy pole.**

## ABSENCES AND LATE STUDENTS

### **Holiday?**

If your child/ren are going to be away during the school term please notify the front office by e-mail, phone, the school app, or come in and pick up a 'Notification of Absence' form.

### **Leaving?**

If your child is leaving the school, please notify the office by completing a 'Termination of Enrolment' form which can be found at the front office.

### **Late?**

If your child arrives to school after the first bell (8:10am), please send them to the front office to be signed in. If they are not signed in they will be recorded as an unexplained absence.

### **Sick?**

If your child is sick please notify the front office by e-mail, phone or the school app. Your child's absence will only be recorded as a notified absence if you advise the school on the day of absence or provide a medical certificate.

## SCHOOL COUNSELLOR

Did you know that Holy Spirit has a school counsellor? Sharon Dodgson our school counsellor works each Thursday.

There are many reasons why parents access counselling for their children, some may be; Family relationships, Separation and divorce issues, Changes in children's behaviour, Social skills Stress and anxiety, Bullying or friendship issues, Anger or violence, Problems at school, or any other issues affecting your child's wellbeing. Parents are very welcome to speak to the counsellor at any time, whether face to face or over the phone. After a referral is made, the counsellor will contact you prior to meeting your child, to discuss any issues. The counsellor will also contact you after counseling starts, to update you on how things are going.

**Confidentiality:** A good counselling relationship is always based on trust, so all of the information you or your child share with the counsellor is of course, strictly confidential. There are a couple of duty of care situations where a counsellor would be obliged to contact a third party, but these only involve extreme situations where it is disclosed that a person may harm themselves or others.

**The Counselling Session:** During counselling sessions, the counsellor uses child-focused activities such as play, stories and resources to help children express their feelings and experiences. The counsellor can also assist with referral to other agencies if required. The sessions usually range in time from 15 – 30 minutes and children generally find them a positive and enjoyable experience.

**Accessing the Counselling Service:** Parents can speak to a teacher, Principal or the counsellor about their concerns and the referral forms are located at the Holy Spirit school reception. Sharon can be contacted at CatholicCareNT on 08 8944 2000 or leave a message at the school office.
