Terms and Conditions

1. Music tuition fees will be paid each lesson. Any music books purchased for the student by the music teacher will need to be paid a lesson time, after notification if diary.
2. Notification of termination of lessons is required in writing, or by contacting the instrumental teacher directly. This can only be done by the Parent or Guardian, not the child.
3. If the student is absent for any reason (illness, excursions or extended holidays) please notify the teacher, or if not available, the school office. N.B. Lack of notification will result in half lesson costs being charged.
4. One recital will be held at the end of Term 3 or 4. This is great opportunity for our parents to meet the music teacher and, most importantly, it gives the students a safe environment to perform in front of an audience. Students will also be given the opportunity to perform at school assemblies.
5. Student will be provided with instrumental materials. They purchase a folder to keep their diary and lesson books. This folder needs to be brought to each lesson. The diary is an aid for parent/teacher communication and the method by which payments are made. A small bag stapled inside the back cover will be provided for this purpose.
6. Tuition for AMEB Exams will be available. These exams are held in May and October, and parents need to indicate their intentions on the enrolment form or discuss with the music teacher.
7. Practice and consistent application are necessary to ensure continued progress. Students are required to practice at least 15 minutes per day. It is expected that they develop a positive attitude toward their lessons and playing the musical instrument. Students are on a trial basis for one term, and if no satisfactory progress is made, lessons can be terminated.
